Despite all the advances in technology and treatment and all the medical milestones scientists have achieved, people with bleeding disorders continue to live with the threat of spontaneous, potentially fatal hemorrhage.

In the US alone, there are approximately 17,000 people with hemophilia and up to 3 million people affected by von Willebrand disease and other bleeding disorders. For these individuals, the very best medical treatment today still often means painful infusions once or twice a week for the entire span of an individual's life. Furthermore, current treatments are not a cure, and many people with hemophilia still suffer from painful, debilitating joint bleeds and a variety of other complications that severely impede their quality of life.

One of the best hopes for a cure rests with gene therapy. Gene therapy trials in humans have begun and are showing great promise. With gene therapy, manufactured genes would be introduced into the body's cells to replace defective genes causing bleeding disorders. Concurrently, other new treatments that show significant promise are also being investigated.

Through the *It's Time for a Cure* campaign, National Hemophilia Foundation (NHF) seeks to raise \$10,000,000 during a five-year period to further bolster NHF's robust research program and to support scientists working in the field of inherited bleeding disorders.
